Wheaton Ice Arena Protocol

1. All individuals entering the facility must wear a mask.

- Skaters and instructors are required to wear face coverings at all times in the facility including while on the ice.
- Skaters will not be permitted to lower their face covering during the class or practice session.
- 2. Skaters will be required to sign in at the front lobby table upon arriving at the rink each week. This is to help with Contact Tracing if needed.
- 3. Skaters may not bring bags into the rink. Skaters must come fully dressed and prepared for their session; this includes skates on.
- 4. Skaters will enter the ice on the North Entrance of the ice rink (near the Zam Bay) and will exit the ice on the South Entrance (near the Locker Rooms). All traffic throughout the facility will be one way.
- 5. All individuals must maintain social distancing of six feet apart off the ice. There are markings throughout the facility to assist with distancing.
- 6. One adult may accompany the skater to assist with skates before the session. Skaters should wash hands or use hand sanitizer before getting on the ice. Sanitizing stations are located at the entrance and exit doors of the ice rink. Stations are also available throughout the lobby.
- 7. Skaters must leave the building immediately after the completion of their session. We ask that you are out of the facility no more than 5 minutes after your session so that staff can properly sanitize the facility for the incoming group.
- 8. Skaters may only be on the ice surface; no entrance into penalty or player's boxes.
- 9. Water fountains are turned off, but Water Bottle Filling stations are available for use.
- 10. Pads must be set up and taken down during your reserved ice time.
- **11.** Nobody is permitted to be on the ice while the Zamboni is.
